How we use cookies

A cookie is a small file which asks permission to be placed on your computer's hard drive, once you agree, the file is added. Cookies allow web applications to respond to you as an individual. The web application can tailor its operations to your needs, likes and dislikes by gathering and remembering information about your preferences.

A cookie in no way gives us access to your computer or any information about you, other than the data you choose to share with us.

This website sets functionality cookies. These cookies allow the website to remember choices you make and provide enhanced, more personal features (such as remembering changes you have made to text size). The information these cookies collect cannot track your browsing activity on other websites.

Most web browsers automatically accept cookies, but you can usually modify your browser setting to decline cookies if you prefer. This may prevent you from taking full advantage of the website.
