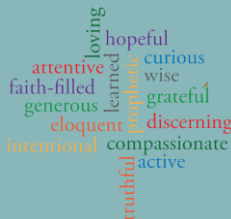



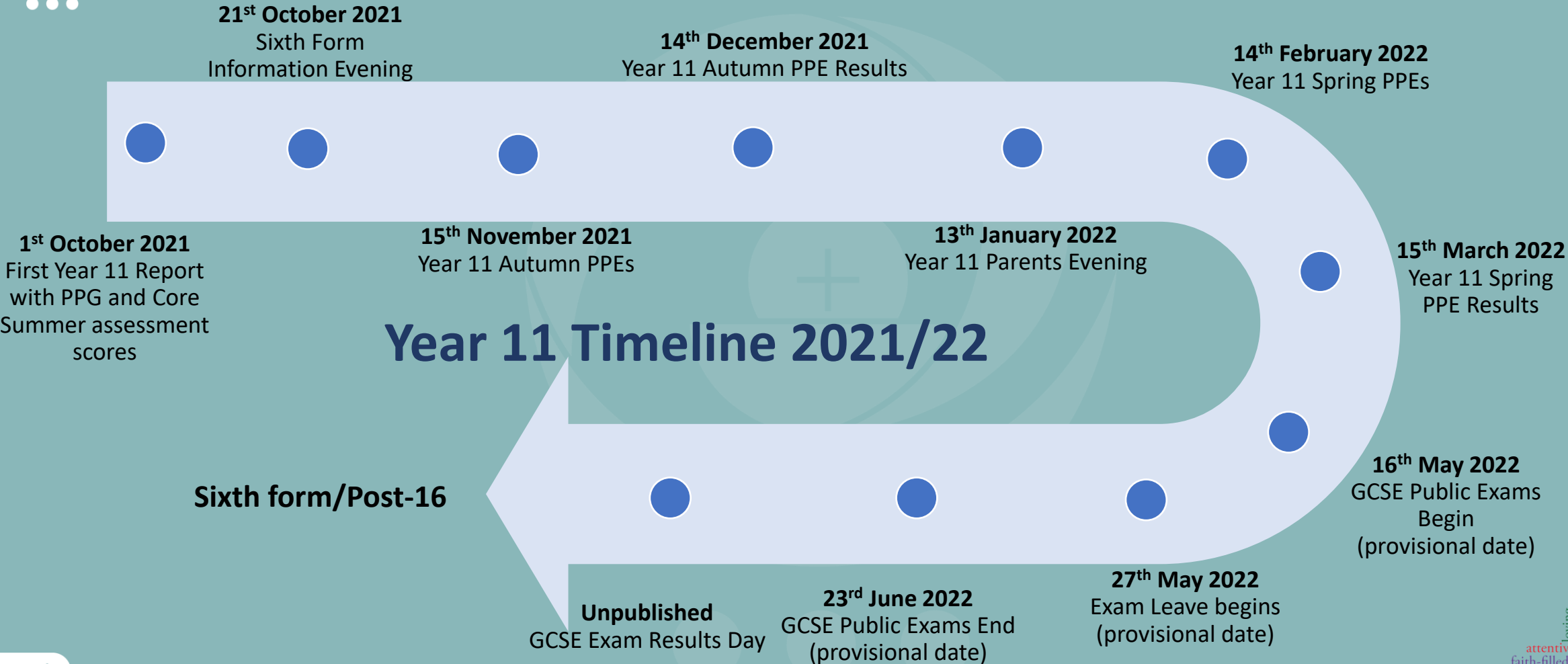

Recovery Curriculum, Intervention & Exams



Recovery Curriculum

Structure of the timetable, students to follow designated courses

Subject leaders – identifying gaps in knowledge and skills, interpreting DfE guidance on NEA, re-sequencing schemes of work, redesigning assessment tasks

Rebuild confidence, self-esteem, belief and opportunity

Intervention

Core intervention during Tuesday P1 - Autumn term plans (w/b 12th October 2021)

Period 5 support sessions – All subjects 3.45pm – 4.30pm

English support/My tutor – One to one sessions

Department intervention strategies – assessment and monitoring, GAP/review tasks, support sessions, provision of additional resources

Exams

Two sets of Pre-public exams to include PIXL Wave for Maths and English

GCSE Public exams provisional timetable for May – June 2022

Awaiting confirmation of DfE proposals on exams and assessment

GCSE Outcomes

Results and outcomes remain some of the best in the area, county and country.

Outcomes in the last two years demonstrate that on average students make at least a third of a grade more progress in all subjects than the national average.

86% of Hagley students achieved grades 9-4 including English and Maths

34% of grades awarded were 9-7 or equivalent.

Standards & expectations

Attendance

Students who have more than 10 days off in their final year at school statistically perform 1.5 grades lower than the average, while students with attendance above 95% (that's no more than 7 days off) achieve over a grade higher on average

Behaviour

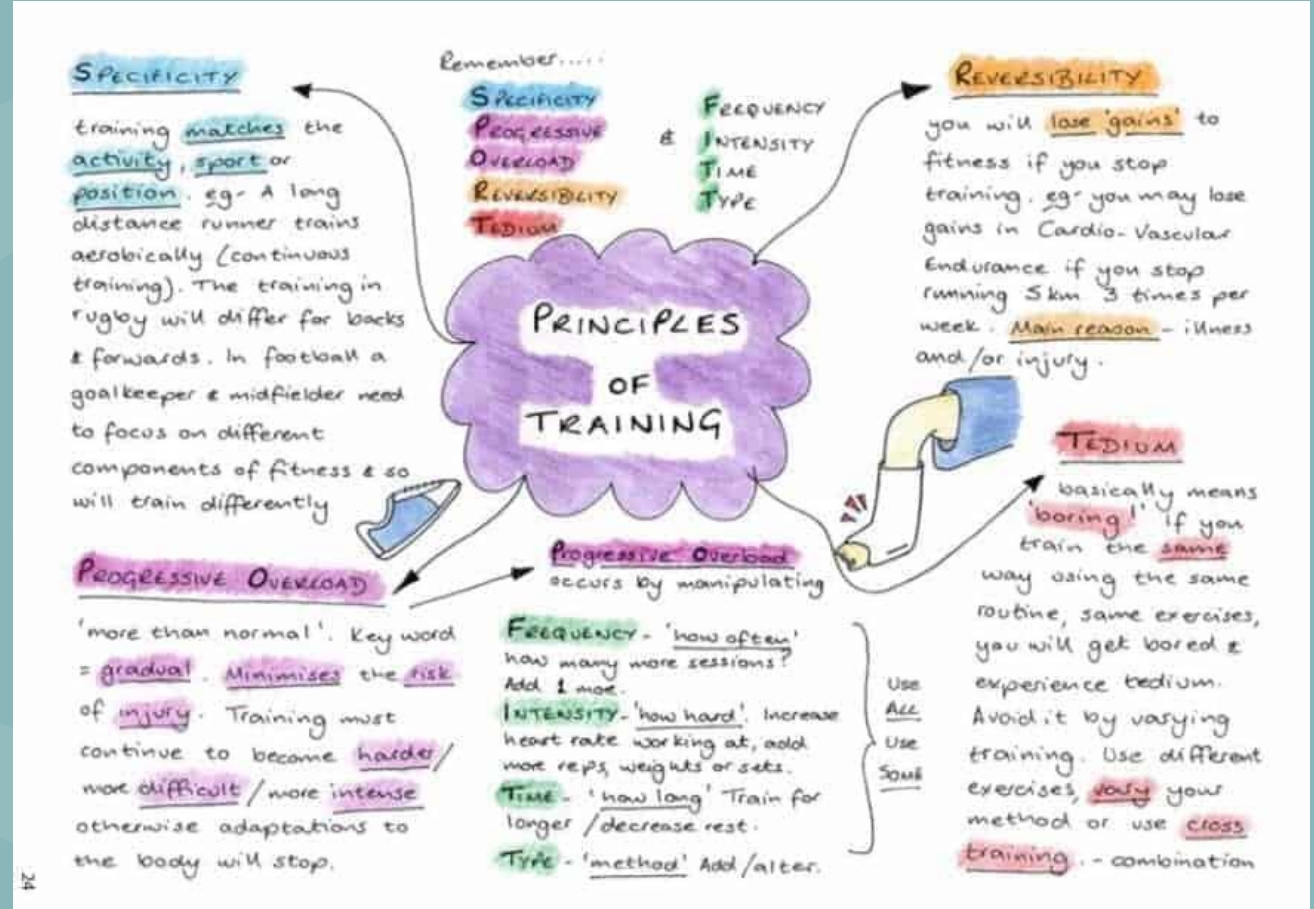

KS5 results

- 26% of students achieved 3A+ or above in facilitating subjects
- Over 50% of the year group achieved a positive progress measure

Courses, Entries, Exams and Exam leave

- There is now no opportunity for courses to be changed or subjects to be dropped – the offer and balance is right
- Final entries will be confirmed in January/February
- All exams must be sat – none attendance of any exam may lead to costs being incurred unless accompanied by a Doctors note
- Exams in Art, Languages and some BTEC qualifications will begin in April if not sooner – dates to be confirmed
- Formal exam season begins wb: Monday 16th May 2022 – this is a provisional date
- The last exam is provisionally set for Thursday 23rd June 2022
- Students will be placed on exam leave no earlier than Friday 27th May 2022
