On our return after half term we began our week first thing on Monday morning reflecting on the Parable of the Ten Bridesmaids which was the Gospel at Mass last Sunday. The Parable reminds us of the importance of being awake and alert to the coming Lord as we do not know the time or the place when he might return.

This Gospel passage links perfectly with our virtue and value for this half term of being **Attentive and Discerning** and as we move through the half term and Advent draws near we will be continually reminding ourselves and each other to be looking out for those moments when we can see Christ in our lives around us but also when we too can be Christ to others, by living out our values.



In supporting the Catholic Life formation of our students and community we have some wonderful opportunities this term. This afternoon 50 students from Year 7 are off to The Briars Catholic Youth Retreat Centre for a weekend of fun and games but also reflection on who they are called to be in their young Catholic lives.

In the coming weeks we also have three in school retreats for Years 8, 10 and 12 being run by The Kenelm Youth Trust (The Diocese Youth Service). Year 8 will explore the theme of encounter and accompaniment. This is is at the heart of our mission at Hagley so that as God's family we ensure every encounter with one another is an encounter with Christ and that we always accompany each other on our journey through life as Jesus did on the road to Emmaus. Year 10 will focus on Catholic Social Teaching and our call to physically live out the values of faith and ensure that we work for the common good and are always focussed on the option for the poor. While the Year 12 retreat will focus on managing mental health and strategies to deal with the challenges of Post 16 life, growth and development.
