Dear Parents/Carers

The scripture that I have shared this week has never been more poignant. I am sure that, like me, many of you have been calling on God during these troubled times. I also hope that you too have felt his closeness, I know I have. The successful return to school that we have experienced this past month has reminded me of the power of faith, hope and belief. Knowledge that in God all things are possible has strengthened all our resolves, and faith that continuing to work together with Christ at our sides will mean that we all get through this difficult period. I am reminded as I write of a phrase Fr Des always used with us; "The Christ in me, meets the Christ in you", and it is in meeting the student's each morning and throughout the school day that I am reminded of the blessings that Christ bestows upon us all, the warm, friendly, kind and considerate students we have here at Hagley.

Recovery and Intervention Programmes

Recovery and Intervention, as I mentioned before, is huge part of our curriculum offer this year as we work to make up for lost time and learning. This week our Year 11s have begun intervention on Tuesday mornings in the core subjects, while KS5 begin after school sessions in specific areas from next week.

In addition to in-school intervention please be reminded that a key part of our KS4 recovery and intervention programme was the launch of GCSEPod in the summer term, a platform that is available to all students in Year 10 and 11.

It is a fantastic resource that students in Key Stage 4 can use to support their learning. The website contains a huge number of exam board specific, short video clips that really help students with the recall and retention of information. Teachers at Hagley are currently setting GCSEPod homework tasks that may include watching a relevant pod before completing an assignment, but students can also access the resources independently. Since July, over 8500 pods have been accessed by the school community! To access GCSEPod, students should visit the website (www.gcsepod.com) and use their Microsoft 365 accounts to log in. Travel and Face Coverings

The wearing of face coverings in school has been a very positive move and students continue to respond to this very well while in school. However please do continue to reinforce with your child the importance of wearing them at all times on trains and buses too, and that just because no one is around to enforce the guidance isn't an excuse to break it.

NHS APP

This week the Government released the NHS COVID 19 Track and Trace App. This App is aimed at adults and student's that are 16+, more guidance can be found <u>here</u>. Students in our sixth form will be encouraged to engage in this.

Free School Meals

I am very aware that the current climate will have put some of our family's jobs and livelihoods at risk. I do very much hope that this is not the case but do expect that sadly some of you may have lost your jobs.

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If this is the case, you may now qualify for additional support for your child through the Free School Meal scheme and regardless of which area/authority you live in you can apply for this scheme via this link: http://www.worcestershire.gov.uk/info/20062/schools/684/applying_for_free_school_meals

Please remember that if you do qualify but your child does not want the free meal it is important you still apply, as additional funding comes into school to help us provide a better education for your child and all Hagley students.

Our Virtual Meet the Tutor Evening for Year 7 is confirmed for Thursday 8th October and letters went home yesterday with Year 7 to all parents/carers inviting them to this virtual meet and greet.

Trains to Kidderminster

I have been informed today by West Midlands Rail (WMR) that the 15:33 train from Hagley to Kidderminster has been cancelled forthwith for the foreseeable future. However, the 15:42 is a confirmed regular train henceforth and will operate with 5 carriages, so we will work with WMR Staff to allocate a carriage to each year group in Years 7 to 11 and ask KS5 students to join Year 11 or wait for the 16:03. Please note that there are currently no plans at present that I am aware of to alter the northbound train times.

Open Morning

Procedures in The Event of a Suspected or Actual Case of COVID-19

I am sure that many of us in trying to process all the information received about Coronavirus are at times uncertain about procedures and actions in the event of a suspected case. The guidance you can find <u>here</u> will certainly help but in a nutshell would remind you that the most important symptoms of coronavirus (COVID-19) are recent onset of any of the following:

- a new continuous cough
- a high temperature
- a loss of, or change in, your normal sense of taste or smell (anosmia)

If your child presents any of these please do not send them into school and begin a period of 10 days in quarantine. Please contact attendance on 01562 883193 Option 1 or email <u>attendance@hagleyrc.worcs.sch.uk</u> by 8.30am to advise us and also make arrangements for a test to be carried out, which this <u>link</u> will advise you on.

If you have other family members who are students at Hagley they must also remain at home and begin a period of 14 days quarantine and you should advise us of this when you call or email. Students who are forced to quarantine will have their work shared with them via their Microsoft Team account or school email. In the event of a negative test and no other family members presenting symptoms your child can then return to school and you should again advise the Attendance Office of this.
