Dear Parent(s)/Carer(s)/Students

I do hope you have found some time to enjoy the beautiful weather today but as I write I can't help feeling frustrated that it won't last into the weekend when we can all appreciate it that little bit more.

This weekend is the Solemnity of the most Holy Body and Blood of the Lord more commonly known by the Latin, Corpus Christi. This solemnity is always held 60 days after Easter or the Sunday immediately after this. The feast of Corpus Christi was proposed by Saint Thomas Aquinas, Doctor of the Church, to Pope Urban IV, in order to create a feast focused solely on the Holy Eucharist, emphasising the joy of the Eucharist being the Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity of Jesus Christ. Lord, you told us that you are the bread of life and that whoever eats of it will live forever. Help each of us to experience the presence of Jesus within us. May Jesus' presence lead us daily into living faith-filled lives. When others look to us may they see Jesus within us. May our example help to transform the world.

### **Transport next week**

I should reiterate the messages that I have already shared this past week about the disruption to the trains next week. There will be no trains on Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday.
