As mentioned, on our return to school this week all consenting students have had two LFD tests at our Asymptomatic Testing Site. This additionally burdensome logistical operation has gone very well in no small part thanks to the attitude and behaviour of the students but also the fabulous team of school staff and volunteers who have worked to operate our site, my very public thanks goes out to them all. Students have now been sent home with a home test pack of seven tests (Years 8, 9 and 10 on Monday). Students are again encouraged to take two tests per week (Sundays and Wednesdays) and record their results via the links at the top of our website that can be found <u>here</u>.
