Dear Parents/Carers

It would be very easy to be disheartened this week after two positive cases that led to the isolation of some students, having not had a case that has impacted on the wider community of the school since November 2020. However, I refuse to let this virus destroy my spirit and I do hope that you too can find that inner strength to remain positive, it feels like we are so very close to a normal again.

I would like to publicly thank the parents and carers of those students now in isolation who reacted so swiftly and with great understanding on Monday and Wednesday of this week.

Yesterday was the feast day of St Catherine of Sienna, who ironically was born during the outbreak of the plague in Italy in 1347. Her writings and works are so influential that she is considered a Doctor of the Church and is one of the most influential and popular saints. Perhaps, like me you will find comfort and strength in her writings. She reminds us that "Out of darkness is born light" that "There is nothing we can desire or want that we do not find in God" and "in Christ crucified you can do anything". Such words of wisdom provide solace, strength and guidance for us all, I hope.

COVID 19 (Testing and Control)

While it is clear to see that the national picture is improving, I must still emphasise the need for us to remain cautious and apply all the relevant control measures. To that end, can I please remind everyone that a student with COVID symptoms or ancillary symptoms must not attend school and book a PCR test at a testing site. Please note Lateral Flow Device Tests that have been sent home are not for those who are symptomatic but asymptomatic. Equally if a child does have a positive LFD home test, please advise school immediately and book a confirmatory PCR test through the NHS website at https://www.gov.uk/get-coronavirus-test or via 119.

In addition, we have seen a drop in the number of reported LFD test results. Please can I remind you that students registered for the home testing programme should be taking a home test twice a week, ideally Sunday and Wednesday, and the results reported via the links on our website homepage.

Parents Evenings

Last night was our last parents evening of the academic year and this time Year 10 students and their families joined teachers online via TEAMS to discuss progress, attainment, engagement and effort.

Much of the feedback I have already had is that online virtual parents evenings have been a great success. Consequently, all Emmaus MAC schools are going out to consultation on whether parents evenings should remain online in future academic years.
