Admission for Year 7 - September 2025

Hagley Catholic High School is part of Emmaus Catholic Multi Academy Company. The admissions authority for the school is the Board of Directors of the Emmaus Catholic Multi Academy Company who has responsibility for admissions to this school. The Board of Directors has delegated responsibility for the administration of the admissions process to the Local Governing Body of Hagley Catholic High School.

The admissions process for Hagley Catholic High School is part of the Worcestershire Local Authority coordinated admissions scheme.

Applications for the Year 7 Intake September 2025 open on **1st September 2024**.

To apply for a place at Hagley Catholic High School in the normal admissions round, an application must be made using the school admission application process of the local authority in which you reside, naming Hagley Catholic High School on the application form.

In addition, a Supplementary Information Form (SIF) **must** also be completed. This can be completed online via MS Forms by clicking on the blue hyperlink link below labelled 'Hagley Catholic High School Supplementary Information Form - Year 7 Intake 2025-26' once applications open for the Year 7 Intake September 2025 open on 1st September 2024.

If your child is a Baptised Catholic, you **must** also provide the school with a copy of their Catholic Baptismal Certificate (electronically as a pdf/jpeg or as a hardcopy) to support their application.

The deadline for **both** application forms and **all** supporting documentation to be completed and submitted is **31st October 2024**.

Applications received after 31st October 2024 will be treated as **late**. This may significantly affect a child's chance of being offered a place at the school.

For further information regarding the school's admissions arrangements including oversubscription criteria, please refer to the Hagley Catholic High School Admission Arrangements 2025-26 below.

Every year the school holds an Annual Open Morning in early October for Year 5 and 6 families to visit the school, meet current staff and students and to ask any questions they may have about secondary education. For the Year 7 Intake - September 2025 our Annual Open Morning will be held on **Saturday 5th October 2024 - 9am until 12.30pm**.

We will be running 90 minute tours for current Year 6 and Year 5 students who are interested in joining our school starting at 9am, 9.30am and 10am for current Year 6 and Year 5 students. Please book your tour time via Eventbrite at [Hagley Catholic High School Open Morning Eventbrite Booking](#)

Families who arrive without a booking will be accommodated with a tour, but booking is preferable and will be prioritised. Tours are limited to one family per ticket and will be with a member of school staff or a current student. All tours will be followed by a talk from Mr Hodgson (Principal).



Whenever there are more applications than places available, priority will be given to Catholic children in accordance with the oversubscription criteria listed in the school's oversubscription criteria. The school is conducted by its Board of Directors as part of the Catholic Church in accordance with its Articles of Association and seeks at all times to be a witness to Our Lord Jesus Christ. As a Catholic school, we aim to provide a Catholic education for all our pupils. At a Catholic school, Catholic doctrine and practice permeate every aspect of the school's activity. It is essential that the Catholic character of the school's education be fully supported by all families in the school. We therefore hope that all parents will give their full, unreserved and positive support for the aims and ethos of the school. This does not affect the right of an application who is not Catholic to apply for and be admitted to a place at the school in accordance with the admission arrangements.

Please note that as well as completing this Supplementary Information Form (SIF), parents must also complete the Local Authority's Common Application Form in order for the application to be complete. This Supplementary Information Form is only for school use and is, in conjunction with the Local Authority's Common Application Form, to enable the Board of Directors to rank applicants using the published oversubscription criteria.

Please note that this is NOT the Local Authority's Common Application Form. As well as completing this Supplementary Information Form (SIF), you MUST also complete the Local Authority's Common Application Form otherwise your application will be deemed incomplete and therefore invalid.



Transport to Hagley

The vast majority of students use the very reliable train service from the station adjacent to the school with a designated secure footpath onto the school grounds. The platform is manned morning and afternoon by Hagley staff to welcome students onto site and to ensure they get on to the train safely to get home.

Our new home to school transport partnership is with Endeavour Coaches Limited who operate a very efficient, safe and excellent value for money service right onto the school grounds for students living in the West Midlands area.

Parents/carers of students on Free School Meals can apply to school for a 20% subsidy for all bus or train travel.




