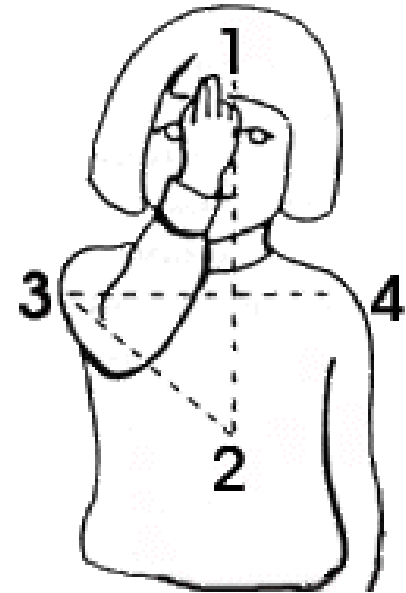
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Teacher:

When we visited you last Autumn we showed you this clip from 2 of our current Year7s describing their 1st couple of weeks at Hagley. Have another quick watch.





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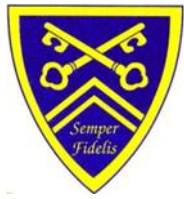

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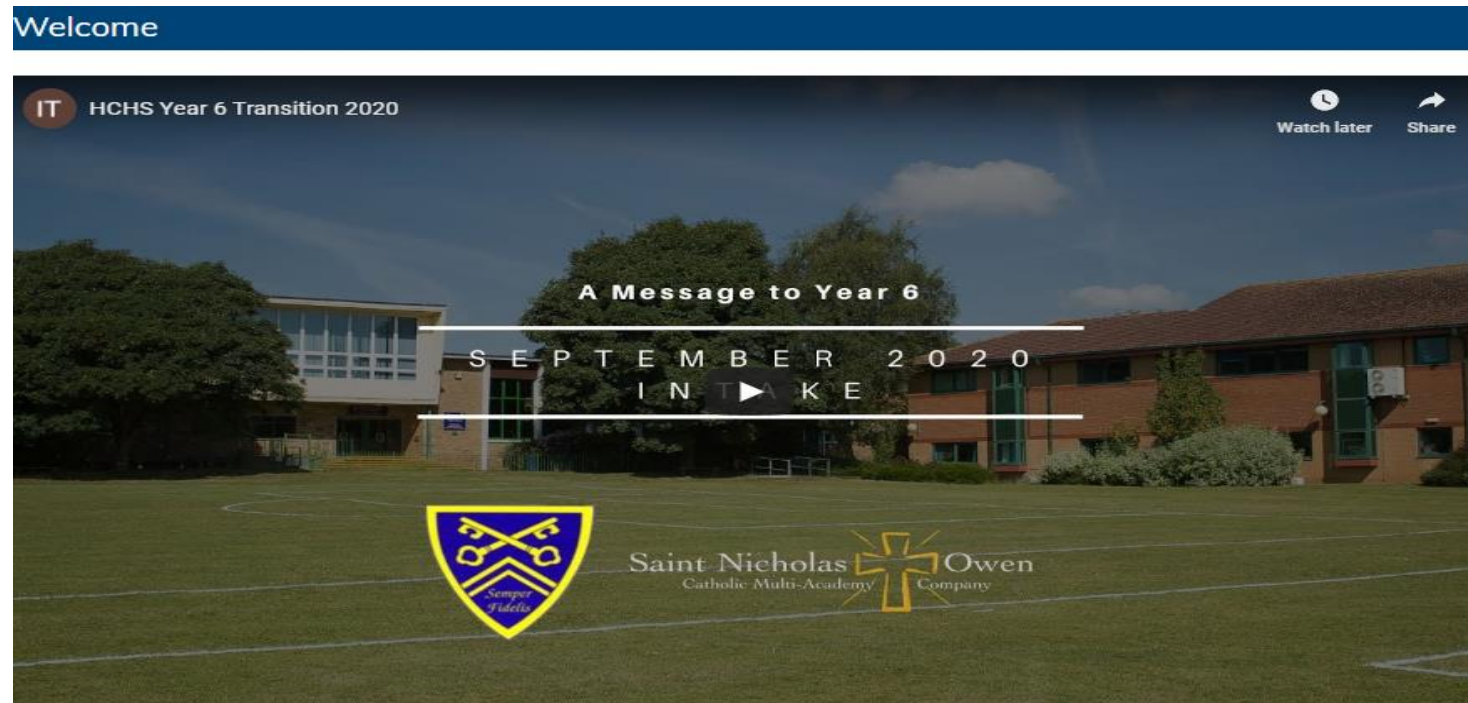

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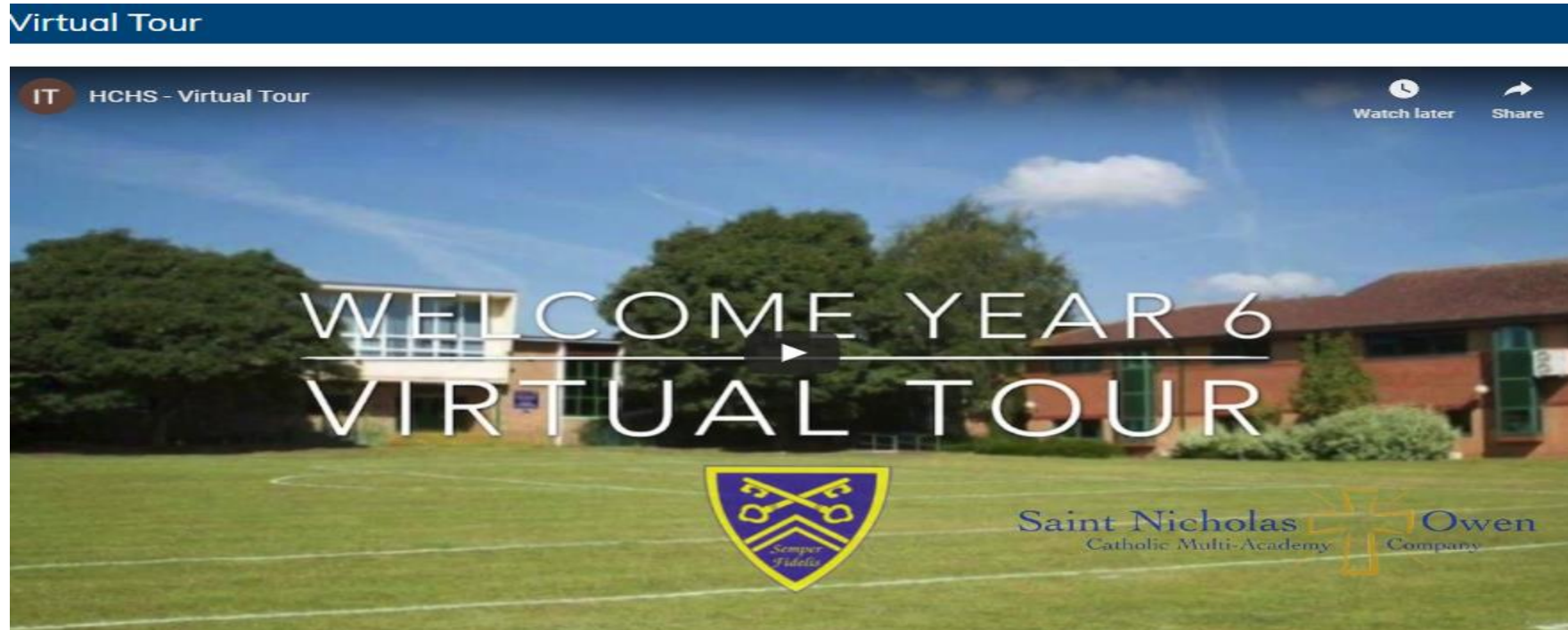
