We hope this email finds you well. Further to our letter dated 26<sup>th</sup> March 2026, we are now writing to you with further information about Intake Information Evening and the upcoming Transition Days for our new Year 7 cohort joining us in September 2026.

**Intake Information Evening – Monday 29<sup>th</sup> June 2026**

We invite all our new families and students to our Intake Information Evening on **Monday 29th June 2026**. This is an important evening as we formally welcome you to the Hagley Catholic High School family. We strongly encourage you to attend as you will be able to meet your child's Head of Year and other key staff.

To accommodate all families there will be 2 intake presentation's taking place:

**At 6.00pm for students with Surnames beginning with letters A-H**

**At 7.00pm for students with Surnames beginning with letters I-Z**

At **5.15pm** our Assistant Principal for Inclusion, DSL and SENDCO, Ms Hackett, will deliver a presentation in the **Hub** outlining what you can expect from SEND provision at secondary school. Parents/carers of students with SEND may wish to attend this additional presentation.

In addition to the intake presentations the evening will also include the following; all of which will be based in our **Sports Hall**. You are free to visit these prior to or after the relevant intake presentation.

- Our school uniform suppliers will be based in the Sports Hall from 3pm - 8.30pm.
- A small amount of second-hand school uniform will also be available by donation.
- Representatives from our school coach service provider will join us if you need to sign up for the dedicated school coach service or have any questions about routes.
- Our SENDCO and Assistant SENDCO's will also be available for any additional SEND questions you may have.
- Our Lead First Aider will be available, should you need to discuss any of your child's medical conditions. If your child does have a medical condition, we do ask you to ensure you meet our lead first aider to ensure all important information is communicated ahead of the transition days.
- Our Admissions Officer, Mrs O'Brien, will be available to meet you and to answer any queries about admissions or the use of Arbor.

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## Transition Days - Wednesday 1st, Thursday 2nd & Friday 3rd July 2026

We welcome all our new students for a three-day transition programme, designed to ensure our students are nurtured and supported as we welcome them to life at Hagley Catholic High School. We recognise what a big step this can be for some of our students, and whilst we hope our new students are excited to join us, we understand there can naturally be nerves and apprehension; our three-day programme will allow students to find their feet and begin to settle into secondary school life.

Students will spend the three days in their new tutor groups and take part in a range of transition activities and lessons, as well as finding their way around the school and learning some school routines. We hope the transition days will also afford students to time to bond with new friends and meet our staff.

We ask that students wear their primary school uniform each day, bring a packed lunch, a refillable water bottle and something to write with. Students will be greeted each day by our staff and should be in school by **8.45am** each morning where they will gather under the canopy area. On Wednesday and Thursday, we will finish at **3.00pm** and on Friday we will finish at the earlier time of **2.00pm**. Any students who will be departing with siblings are welcome to wait until 3.25pm when the official school day ends, they will be supervised in this time.

**For registration purposes, please complete the MS Form below to confirm if your child will be attending each of the Transition Days and to indicate how they will be travelling home. It is imperative that you let us know how your child will be getting home each day so we can ensure their safe departure from us.**
