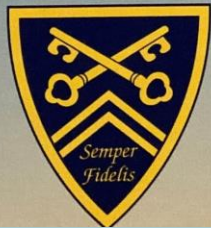

Communicating with us

Pastoral Care

- Students are placed in Houses/tutor groups based on information provided at transition meetings with their primary schools.
 - A tutor group is a place to develop new friends and grow as a person.
- Students meet with their form tutor daily and start the day with line up under the canopy.
- Form tutors are a key contact in supporting your child's wellbeing and welfare.
 - They deliver your child's Character, Culture & Formation Curriculum (RSE, PSHE, Citizenship, British Values)
 - Mass (every 6 weeks)
 - Assembly and collective worship
 - DEAR Literacy Programme
 - The HUB is our learning support and safe refuge; additional support is available for students with additional needs

Praise & Reward

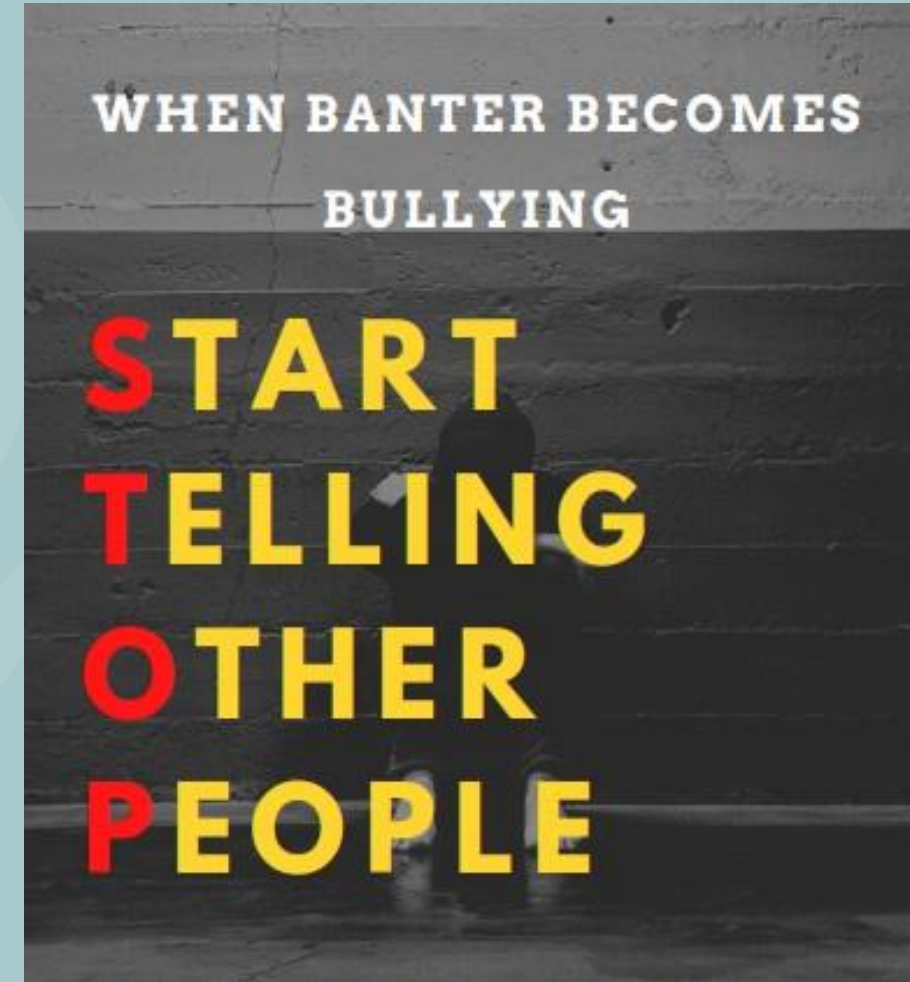
- Recognising and celebrating student's achievements is integral to our school culture and community.

- Praise and recognition in a range of other ways; such as star of the week.



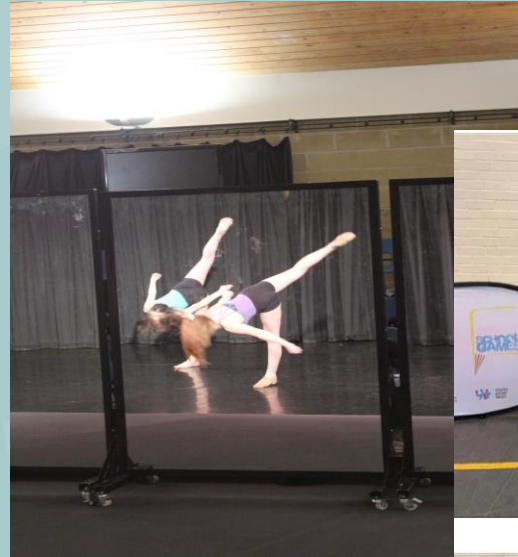
Anti-Bullying

Other Uniform Items

- **No** extreme haircuts or hair colouring including skin fades
- Piercings: one small plain stud may be worn in each ear. No other piercings are permitted.

- False eyelashes, varnished/acrylic/gel/shellac nails are **not** allowed.



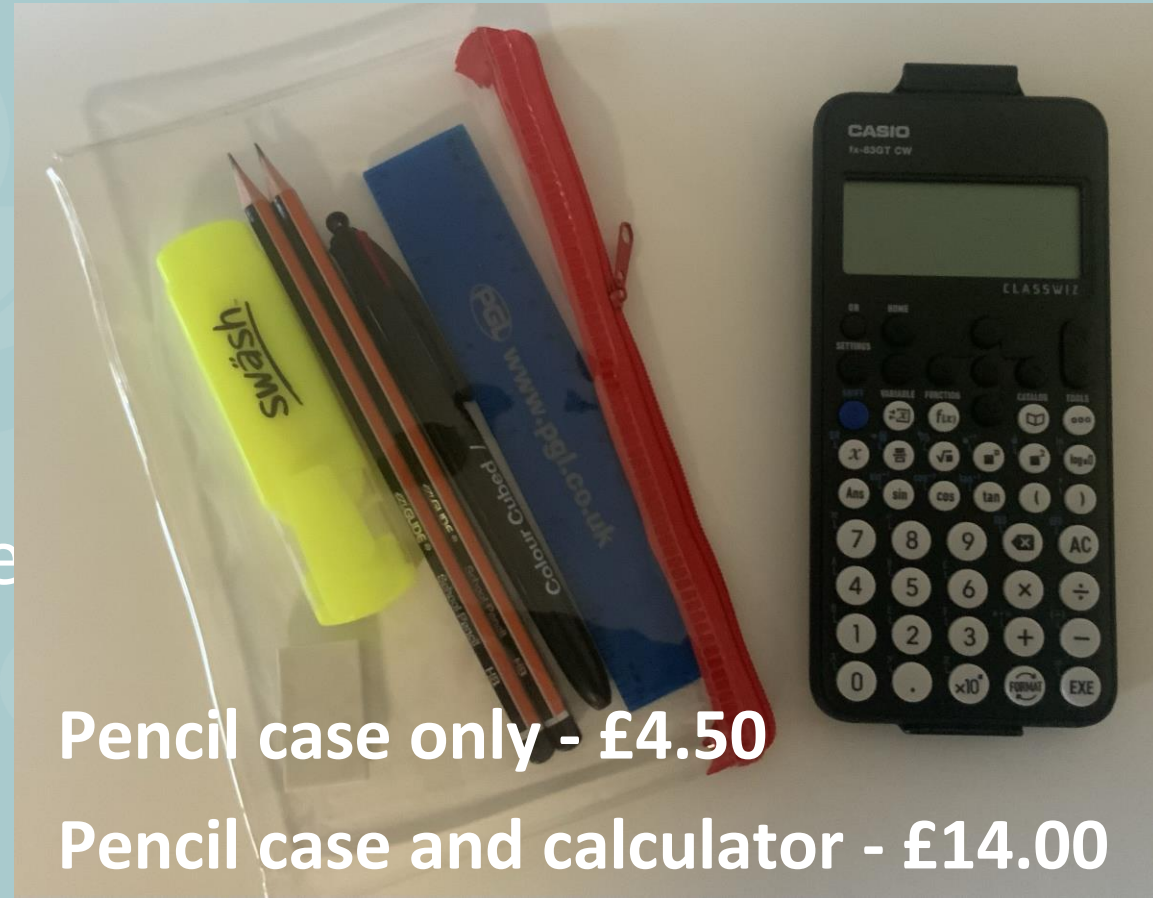

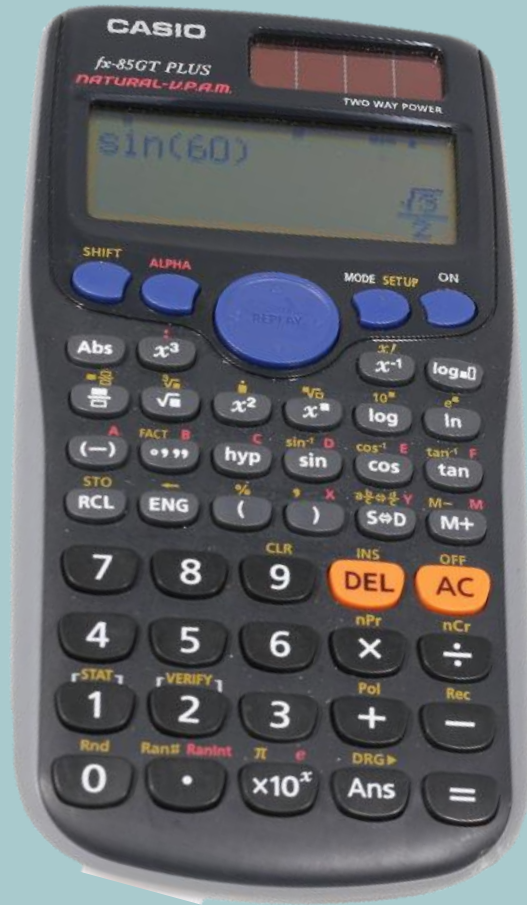

Hagley Catholic High School Pupil Premium Pledge

At Hagley Catholic High School, we are committed to removing barriers for all students, both academic and pastoral, to help them to achieve their personal best in Christ. To enable our students to become their personal best, we offer **all** our students the following as part of our universal offer:

- High quality teaching in all subjects
- A comprehensive and supportive pastoral system
- An education founded in our Catholic virtues and values.

No child at Hagley will be disadvantaged in learning, or wider curriculum opportunity due to personal circumstances; our school is a **safe refuge** for all, that endeavours to develop **POWERful** learners, regardless of circumstance. We recognise that parents/carers worry about the costs of secondary school, and we want to ease such anxiety and support in any way we can.

All schools are in receipt of additional funding to support children who are in receipt of free school meals, have families in armed service or are previously Looked After, while Local Authorities receive additional funding for those children who are Looked After. It is recognised that these students may have additional barriers to achieving their academic potential and to cultural enrichment opportunities. In working to remove these barriers and reduce the academic and cultural gap we offer our three priority promises:

Priority 1:

- Marking of all homework, assessments and class books first.
- Formative assessment in all lessons first.
- Priority booking for all parent/carer evenings. Parents/carers will be able to book slots up to 48 hours before the system opens to other parents/carers.
- First access to in school academic interventions in reading and maths and SEMH support.
- A fully stocked Hagley Toolkit (pencil case and calculator) at the start of the school year.

Priority 2:

By the time our students leave Hagley they will have had the opportunity to:

- attend a curriculum enrichment trip in Year 7, Year 8 and 9 that is partially funded.
- participate in at least one extracurricular activity or club.
- had the opportunity to join our numerous leadership groups including the Chaplaincy Team, The Voice (Student Council), Transition Ambassadors and Y11 Prefects amongst others.

Priority 3:

Financial support to include :

- Financial support of up to 10% and no more than £50 on any curriculum related trip/residential once per year.
- Financial support of up to 20% on travel expenses (trains and school buses) to enable your child to attend Hagley Catholic High School. ***Please note that in this instance we can only refund you once the train pass or bus pass has been purchased. If you choose to pay in instalments, we can only refund you up to 20% of an instalment at a time.***
- A £50 voucher to be spent with our uniform suppliers each year.
- Selected revision guides and materials to help students achieve their potential.
