Induction

I do hope that you were able to watch the virtual induction presentation sent last week, if not it is still available to view here [here](#).

I can confirm that the first day for Year 7 will be Monday 6th September 2021. Students should arrive from 8.40am for a 9am start and will be met at the front of the school by staff and directed to the canopy. Parents/carers accompanying their child to school should drop off their child in the car park and not come into the school premises. The day will follow normal times, with students finishing at 3.35pm. Other than Year 12 there will be no other students on site and this will ensure that students can have an appropriate induction programme.

At the end of the day, students will be supervised by staff outside D block as they await collection from parents/carers or escorted to the train station or bus pick up point. Again, parents/carers must remain in their cars and not walk into the site. Students should bring with them either a packed lunch or have cash already loaded to their ParentPay account (ParentPay details to follow in the post). Biometrics will be taken during the induction day to allow for cashless payments where consent has been received. Students should also bring to school a face covering, school bag and any medication that is required for the day.

An update on the bus service can be accessed [here](#) and Thandi Red Limited can be contacted directly after 23rd July to purchase passes. There will be a bus service running on Monday 6th September for those students who catch the bus.

As per the letter sent by Mr Hodgson on 8th July, COVID testing will take place over the first six school days for students with consent. For the full information and details on how to provide consent, the letter is available to view [here](#).

Students meet daily in their form groups with their form tutor. The form tutor is a key person in ensuring that your child is happy at school. Form groups are deliberately mixed up to enable students to make new friends and are not the same as teaching groups. During the first days at Hagley, students will take part in ice-breaker activities to get to know their peers and throughout their journey at Hagley will represent their house in competitions, for example, on sports days. Attached to this email is a letter from one of our Year 7 students for your son/daughter to read. It is not possible for students to move form groups before September.

I wish you and your family a happy and restful summer and from all of us at Hagley we look forward to welcoming you into our school family in September. I would like to leave you with these words of St Paul in his letter to the Philippians:
