Dear Parents/Carers

I am writing to you today to inform you and your child of the house he/she will be in when they join Hagley in September.

I am pleased to announce that your son/daughter will be in _____ house. The coloured stripe on the school tie you need to purchase for your child is _____.

Students meet daily in their house groups with their form tutor. The form tutor is a key person in ensuring that your child is happy at school. Form groups are deliberately mixed up to enable students to make new friends and are not the same as teaching groups. During the first days at Hagley, students will take part in ice-breaker activities to get to know their peers and throughout their journey at Hagley will represent their house in competitions, for example, on sports days. Please find attached to this email a letter from one of our current Year 7 students for your son/daughter to read.

A reminder that **Intake Information Evening** is on **Monday 4th July 2022**, where uniform and PE kit can be purchased from **4.30pm – 9.30pm** in the gymnasium. The Principal's talk will begin at **6pm** and you will also have the opportunity to meet key staff on the evening who will be involved in your child's school life here at Hagley.

On **Wednesday 6th July 2022, Induction Day**, your child should gather under the canopy for a **9am start** in their current school uniform to take part in their induction day where they will meet their form tutor, form group and take part in a variety of activities, including an inter-form sports challenge on the school field which trainers will be required for. In preparation for the induction day on Wednesday 6th July, if you haven't already done so, please complete the following form <https://forms.office.com/r/A4n3yyQZGR>.

Students should be collected at 2.45pm or can remain in school until 3.35pm if going home with a sibling. If you require any further information regarding transition, please visit our [Year 6 transition page](#) on our school website.

In September, the first day for Year 7 will be **Wednesday 7th September 2022**, where students should arrive to school for **8.55am** and gather under the canopy in their Hagley uniform. Over the coming weeks, please check your emails regarding your Arbor log-in details, this is our management information system and is used to share and communicate information with you. Please log in to Arbor to provide consent for biometrics, which is used for the cashless dinner system and GDPR consents prior to your child starting Hagley on their first day. If you require a paper copy of any of the consent forms, please contact the school office.

If you have any final queries before the end of term, please contact admissions@hagleyrc.worcs.sch.uk. Please note that the end of the term is Thursday 21st July 2022 and queries sent after this date will not receive an immediate response.
