\* Initial thoughts are that this drop is partly to do with the reduction in programme from four to three A' levels as a standard, with a significant reduction in AS examinations taken as new A levels were introduced. The other factor is the relative weakness of the cohort, with a GCSE Attainment 8 of 4.8, compared with 5.4 for the previous year; more than half a grade lower at GCSE.
