Year 9 Pathways Process 2023

The Pathways Programme will officially be launched to Year 9 in an assembly on **Tuesday 31 January 2023**. This is an exciting prospect for all students as it gives them an opportunity to guide and personalise their own curriculum for the very first time. The decisions that they make at this point in their education are incredibly important and they should seek guidance from parents/carers and school staff to make the 'right' choices for them.

With this in mind, I would like to highlight some key dates. Pathways Evening will take place on **Wednesday 8 February 2023** and will commence at **6.30pm** with an address in the hall. **Please note that this is a change of date from what was originally published.** Parent(s)/carer(s) and students will then be invited to attend a number of presentations by subject leaders who will provide information regarding the specific courses that are available in each subject area. We would expect the evening to end by 8:05pm.
