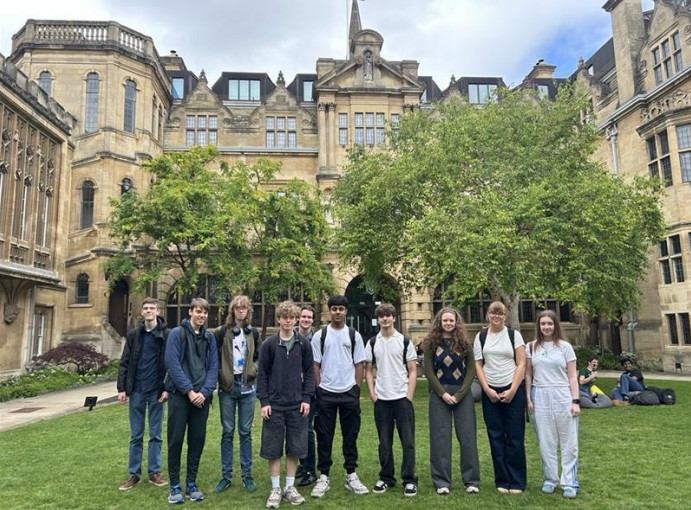

YEAR 12 HIGHER EDUCATION

During our Higher Education and Apprenticeships fortnight, Year 12 students participated in an extensive Higher Education and Careers programme designed to support their next steps beyond Sixth Form. Students participated in a variety of informative sessions, including workshops on Student Finance and University life delivered by the Universities of Worcester and Aberystwyth and a wide range of seminars hosted by professionals from numerous industries and career sectors. The students were also guided in beginning their UCAS applications. In addition, the programme consisted of a range of trips focused on post-18 study, including a trip to the University of Oxford, the chance to experience English and History lectures at the University of Birmingham, the UCAS Discovery Event at the NEC and the University of Birmingham open day, providing valuable opportunities to explore future study and career pathways as they prepare for life beyond Sixth Form.
